

Highwood Primary School Four Year Trend for children achieving the expected standard at the end of KS2













Highwood Primary School Four Year Trend for children achieving the higher standard (110 scaled score) at the end of KS2









Due to an large increase in demand for school places in the Year 2 cohort, Highwood Primary took an additional Year 2 class after the easter holiday (23/04/19).







Highwood Primary School Four Year Trend for children achieving the expected standard at the end of KS1











