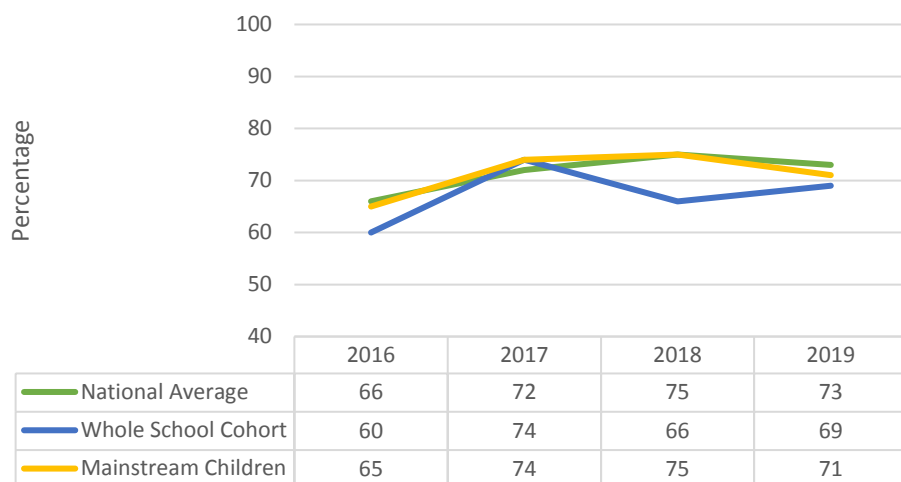

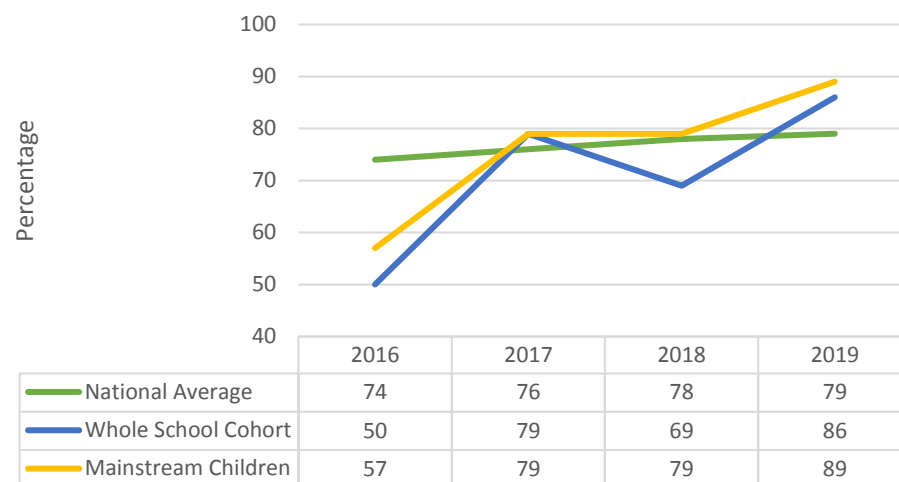

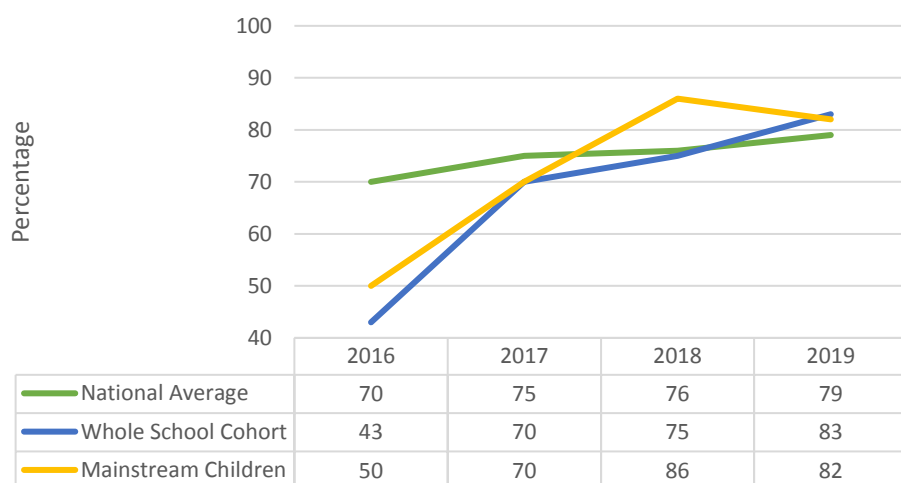
### Highwood's KS2 EXS 4 Year Trend for Reading



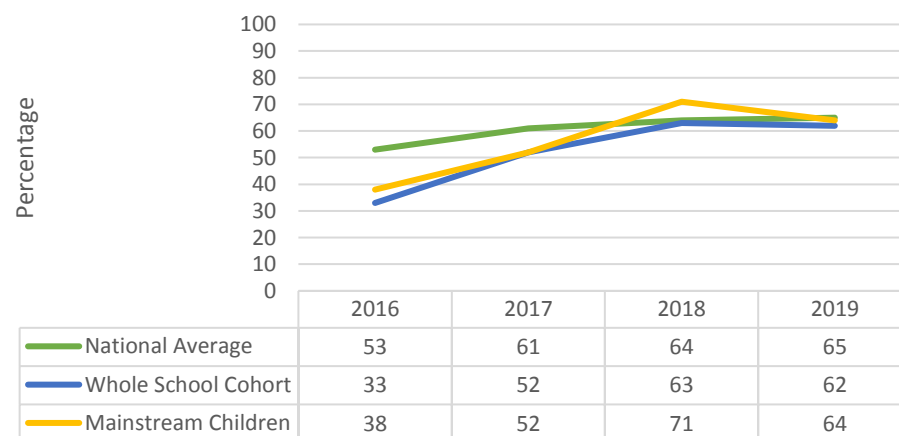
### Highwood's KS2 EXS 4 Year Trend for Writing



### Highwood's KS2 EXS 4 Year Trend for Maths

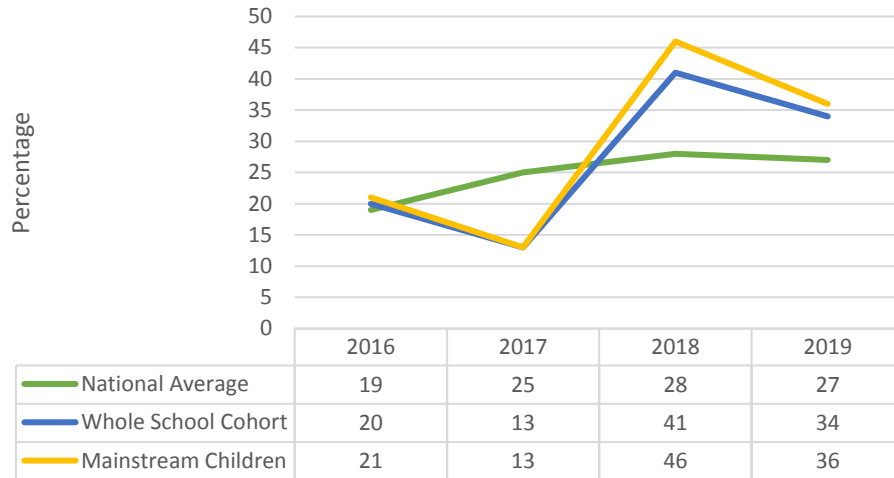


### Highwood's KS2 EXS 4 Year Trend for RWM combined

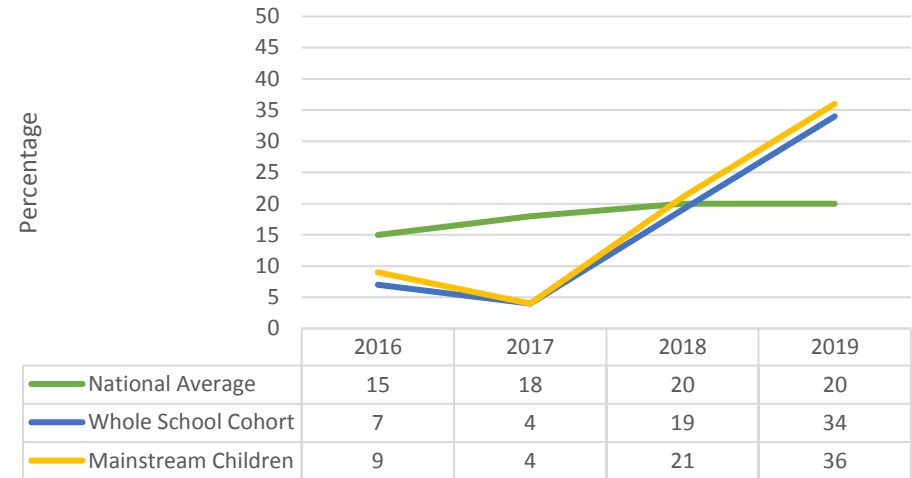


## Highwood Primary School Four Year Trend for children achieving the higher standard (110 scaled score) at the end of KS2

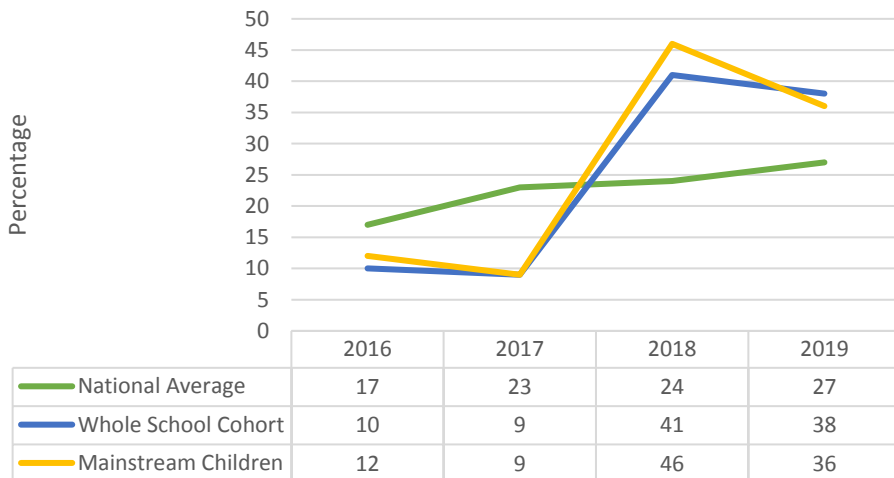
### Highwood's KS2 GDS 4 Year Trend for Reading



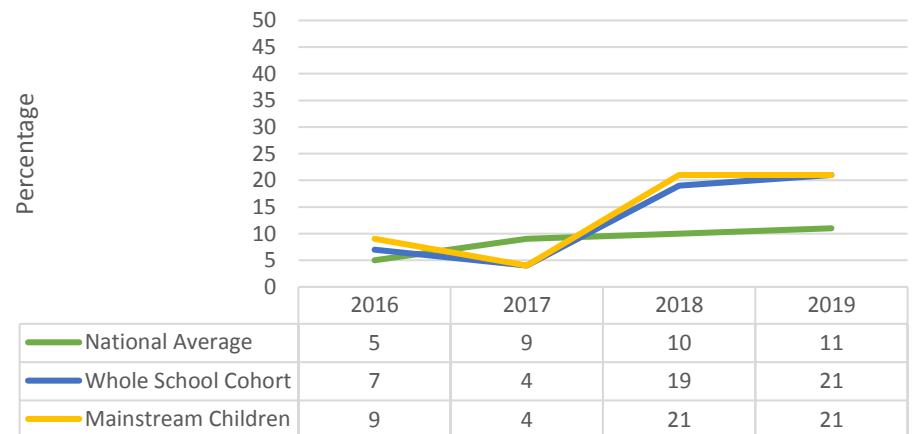
### Highwood's KS2 GDS 4 Year Trend for Writing

The first table below show the whole school data for all children on roll.

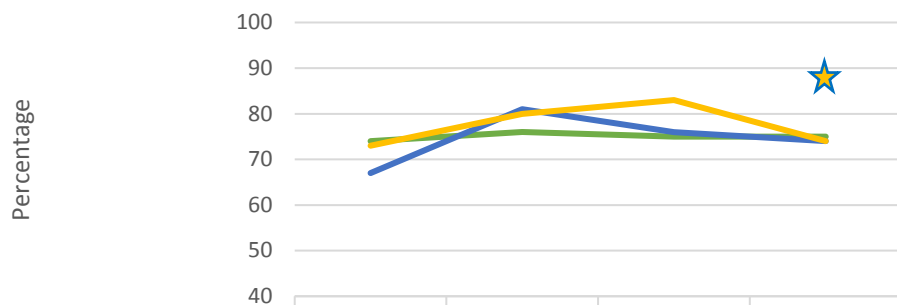

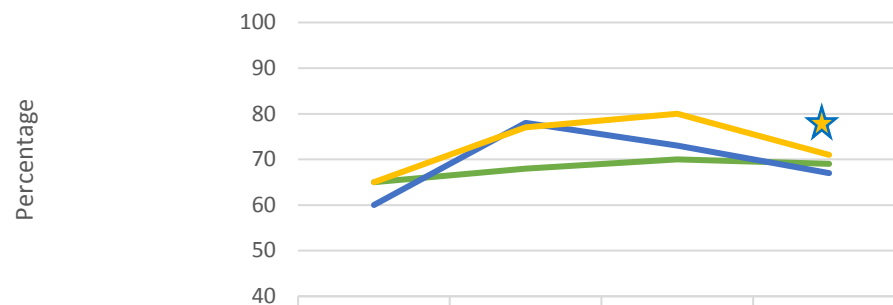

### Highwood's KS1 EXS 4 Year Trend for Reading



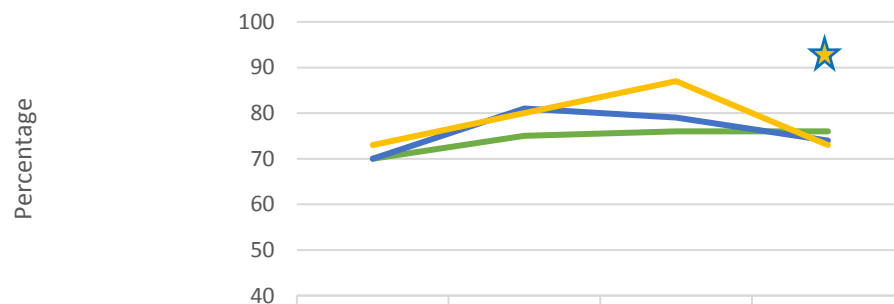

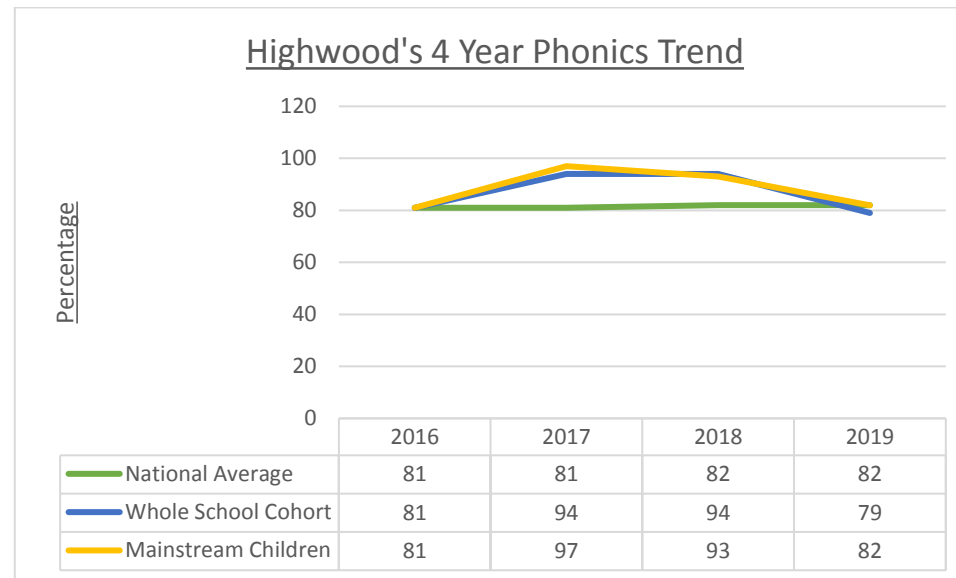

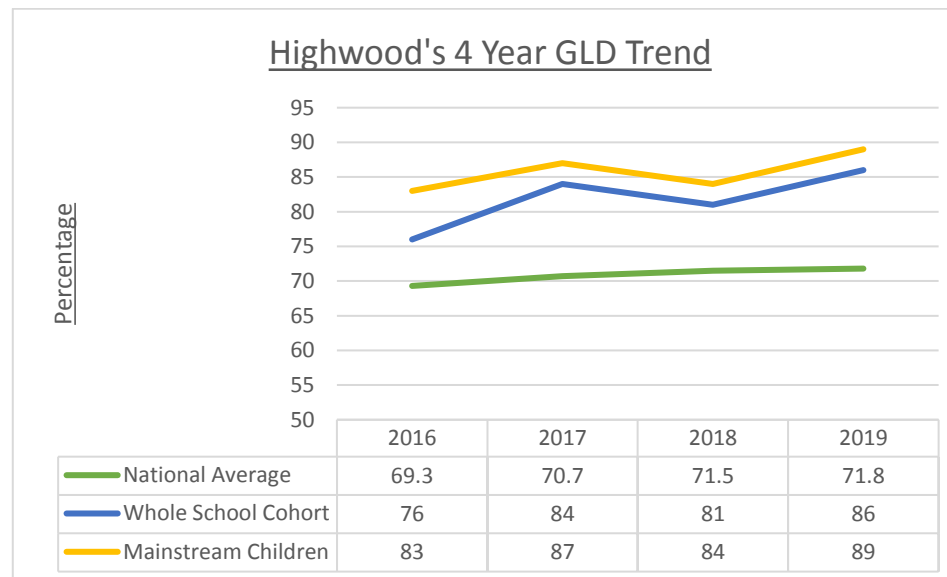
