


Helping Children with Maths

Entry requirements for the course

To access this course you will need to be 19 or older as of 31st August 2020, be a citizen of the EEA and have been resident in the EEA at least 3 years (NB a number of exemptions also apply, if you are not an EEA citizen please contact us to check your eligibility).

You should be able to read and write in English and have a basic understanding of maths so that you can support children with their learning.

If you have additional learning needs

Please identify your needs on the application form ahead of the course so we can work with you to prepare any support you may need. You can also discuss any needs with your tutor on the first session.
