Dinton Activity Centre is based at Wokingham's Dinton Pastures Country Park. Our facilities beside Black Swan Lake are surrounded by 350 acres of meadows and woodland. Come to us to try your hand at everything from canoeing to rock climbing, and then relax and enjoy refreshments.

We can organise bespoke events for groups for team building and celebrations. Each event requires a minimum of six people. We also take children's parties from the age of 8 upwards. Our prices are detailed below:

Rock Climbing: Challenge yourself and try out our 6.5 metre rock climbing wall and traverse wall. If you prefer, we can even bring the rock face to you. (Additional charges may apply).

Dinghy Sailing: Dinghy sailing offers you a chance to have fun on the water and learn the basics of how to handle a dinghy.

Kayaking and Canoeing: Learn how to paddle before exploring Black Swan Lake from the water, playing games and facing challenges to master the craft.

Kata-Kanus: If you want to have fun and get people working together; try Kata Kanus. You'll be six to a boat so synchronised paddling is essential.

Stand Up Paddleboarding: Try out the latest craze and have a go at paddleboarding. Enjoy the lake from a new perspective whilst keeping your balance and learning a new technique.

Geocaching/Orienteering: A casual stroll or heated race around the Country Park searching for controls or geocache. A test of your navigation skills and sense of direction!

Raft Building: Work together or in teams to create a stable raft from wooden poles and rope. Then take out it on the water to test it out.

Powerboating: Have a go at driving our fleet of powerboats. Gain an understanding of boat handling, safety and precision manoeuvres. *Additional charges apply*
