

Wokingham Housing-Related Support Service



Our support service provides assistance with housing-related issues, to help people to stay living in their own homes.

The areas that are covered include:

- Help with financial issues, budgeting, rent or mortgage payments, debts, applying for welfare benefits
- Advice on maintaining a safe and secure home
- Support with physical, emotional and mental health
- Advice on finding training or employment
- Liaison with partner agencies, for example the local authority
- Support to access social and leisure activities
- Signposting of other advice and support services

Our support service is available for adults with a range of needs including:

- People with mental health problems
- Learning disabilities and physical disabilities
- Older people
- People with drug and alcohol problems
- Other vulnerable adults
