Located at the heart of the school, it is used as a base for pupil interventions but also to host family events and courses. It also has an office, where Mrs. Lucy Sayer, (Parent Support/ Family Support), and Mrs. Lisa Hall, (Attendance Officer) work, providing a point of contact and support for Highwood families. In the last year we have;

- Run workshops for parents helping them support their youngesters with anxiety.
- Held new starter coffee mornings, for parents to meet staff and meet one another.
- Had a number of local charities host coffee mornings, providing families with signposting and support, (Promise, Inclusion, Transform Housing, Communicare, Camp Mohawk).
- Worked with Wokingham Adult Learning to run education courses for parents, providing them with the tools to help support their children's learning.
