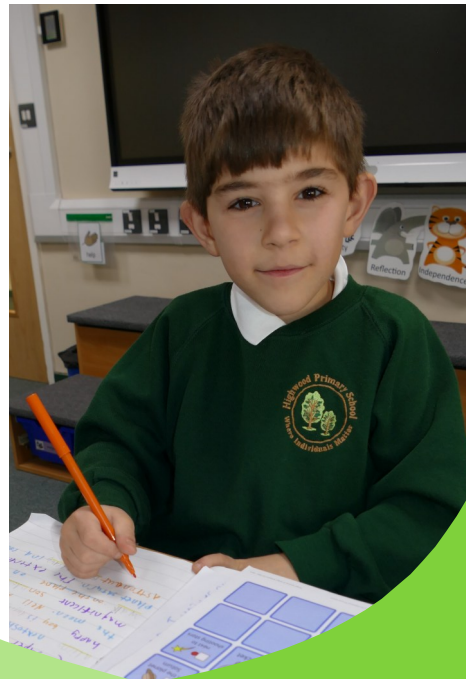

## Who we are

The Grove is the Resource Base attached to Highwood Primary School for children with Developmental Language Disorder (DLD) and those requiring specialist speech and language therapy. We have been successfully supporting children aged 4-11 with long-term speech, language and communication needs for many years-

We support resource children in specialist morning lessons, spending up to 50% of the time in the resource base, and afternoons in their mainstream classes.

We provide a nurturing environment where every child is supported through tailored, child-centered planning and professional expertise. Our approach helps remove barriers to learning, enabling pupils to access the mainstream classroom and flourish as valued members of the school community.

We offer an outreach program to local schools that includes universal and targeted training for staff, specialist pupil support and specialist dual placement within The Grove.

Highwood Primary School is proud to have achieved Elklan Communication Friendly Setting Accreditation in September 2023 and works to prioritise an inclusive learning environment.



## Who we work with

Children who:

- ✓ Have an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP)
- ✓ Have speech and language difficulties as their primary need
- ✓ Have a potential diagnosis of DLD
- ✓ Are currently in primary provision
- ✗ The pupil's needs are not as a bi-product of other conditions such as Autism, hearing loss, social emotional mental health, or general learning difficulties.

## Outcomes for The Grove pupils

We aim to 'close the gap' in attainment and confidence with our student's mainstream peers. To give the pupils the skills and understanding to self advocate and have a toolkit of strategies for learning. Our students are supported to move into mainstream provision, when they are ready, including mainstream secondary school.
