Sometimes, I try to do something new.








Sometimes I get it right.

Everyone makes mistakes.




Kids make mistakes. Grown-ups make mistakes too.










A mistake means I am still learning.







If  I  make a mistake,  I can  take  a deep  breath.








 I can  ask  for help.
